PERFORMANCE SERVICES

MOTION by **C. Lee**, SECONDED BY Member **H. Burnett**, the Buchanan Board of Education has selected Performance Services Inc. (PSI) team to provide architectural and construction management services on an "as needed basis" for projects. PSI will assist the district with long term planning, architectural and construction management services and bond support activities. In addition, PSI will work to utilize local contractors, provide no charge order guarantees, educational programming analysis, open book pricing, collaborative development and bond services to aid the school with informing the public.

Mrs. Robinson spoke of the facilities committee meeting in which 3 companies shared their ideas. One of the goals includes improvements to Moccasin Elementary and Buchanan High School. BHS will be 100 years next year. Mrs. Robinson explained they will do a facilities audit and present to the board.

BUS LEASE

MOTION by **C. Lee**, SECONDED BY Member **R. Writer**, the Buchanan Board of Education approves Director of Transportation, Mahlon Williams', recommendation to:

- 1. Sell Bus #2 and purchasing Bus #9 off lease for \$53,000.00
- 2. Lease 3 Conventional Buses 3 years @ \$15,986.00/year

Mrs. Robinson informed the board that we have a number of bus leases that will be in need of renewal at the end of this school year. We are looking to purchase bus #9 which is a handicap accessible bus. Mr. Williams is working on obtaining grants for the buses as well so that lease costs might be reduced for the district. He explained leasing also helps with maintenance costs since repairs are covered.

TRANSPORTATION E-Z ROUTING APPROVAL

Mr. Williams explained that Poly Plot uses Michigan State Maps which are not as up to date as Google Maps. Here Comes the Bus APP is not working because it is not syncing with the Poly Plot maps. With the E-Z Routing system, the parents can log into the system and make the requests. Mrs. Laesch also commented that GPS will be nice when we have sub drivers. She also appreciated the hands on system.

Facility Planning Committee – Mr. Lee provided an update to the board. There were three construction/architectural companies who presented to the committee; Site Logiq, Owens, Aimes & Kimball, and Performance Services. The committee felt most comfortable with Performance Services because the bond, construction/project managers and architect are all under one umbrella so there could be no finger pointing. They convinced the committee that they would do the project at high speed and lower cost since they are all under one roof.

Finance Committee – Mr. Carlson briefed the board of the most recent meeting. Don Sovey presented information on zero based budgeting. He does site assessments which mostly cover the budget in the business office and better uses of our resources. It is an outside look of our budget and where the money is getting spent. Mr. Carlson also said the committee reviewed the budget amendment, substitute teacher pay and items related to transportation.
