Attendance

Our attendance policy was structured to keep kids in school and ensured that they were successful in their studies. However, due to COVID, we have had to relax our attendance policy and that has had some severe ramifications on the students and their grades.

Student absences in 2017 averaged around 46 students per day (with a high of 85). This year our student absences average around 89 per day (with a high of 146). Our teachers are doing their best to make sure that students who are absent get caught up, and this takes an immense amount of time and energy while trying to keep current in our curriculum pacing. Most teachers have decided to slow the pace, and enlist peer mentors to help students get caught up. Unfortunately, the effects of COVID are long-lasting. Teachers are re-teaching various content materials to various groups of students, each who have missed different lessons. Our teachers are determined and doing their best to engage students. If your student has been absent, please be sure they are attending our After School Academics to get caught up on missing work as well as reinforcing getting the help they need to be successful, whether that's one-on-one with the teachers after school, attending the scheduled ICE sessions, or just ensuring that students stay in school as much as possible and completing work when they are out.
