**Leroy Bobbitt**



Class of 1962. Leroy was the first African American quarterback in BHS history leading his team to an 8-1 record and a co-championship in the Big 5 Conference. He varsity lettered four years in football and baseball, three years in basketball, and one year in track. His talents were not limited to sports; he received the only "1" rating for Cornet Solo at the State Solo & Ensemble Festival in 1962. A Michigan State graduate who went on to be one of the first three African Americans to graduate from Stanford Law School. Leroy is a partner at Loeb & Loeb, the world's largest entertainment law firm, in Los Angeles and is also a Hall of Fame inductee for the Langston Bar Association and the Black Entertainment & Sports Lawyers Association.
