Sharon Gregorski

Sharon Gregorski was an educator and coach at Buchanan Community Schools for 38 years.

During her time at Buchanan Community Schools, she taught english language arts, physical education, and science. She was also a coach and middle school athletic director.

Along with Diane Warmbein, Mrs. Greg helped to establish the high school girl's softball, basketball and volleyball programs in 1972. Thanks to her efforts to lay the foundation, today these programs have grown to become very successful.

Mrs. Greg and Jim Brohman had the pleasure of team-teaching during their time as the "Coolness Block." Together they traveled to Stanford University to participate in a program for teaching math to middle school students sponsored by the Institute for Research on Learning. Sharon was the only non-math teacher to attend. Her perspective allowed the program to be expanded from an exclusive math program into a curriculum-wide program. Together they lectured at Stanford University presenting their ideas to teachers.

After leaving Buchanan, Sharon spent eight years as the principal for Saint Mary's school in Niles. She retired after 47 years in education in June 2017. Mrs. Greg has touched countless lives as an educator, coach, principal and friend. She will always be known as "Mrs. Greg" to her students.
